Upon receiving case on 9/22/83, I contacted COMPLAINANT, NANCY VANBEBBER at 1717 S. 2nd. That afternoon at 1P, both NANCY VANBEBBER and ELIZABETH AVERY came to my office where they did give me a written statement of facts and did say that they did wish to file charges on the two SUSPECTS. ELIZABETH AVERY told me that she recognized two of the SUSPECTS which will be RICHARD SHANNON MILKS and ALVIN CLAY JENKINS. She said that when she peered through the door she could see both of them and could positively identify both of them as being two of the men that were there. ELIZABETH AVERY told me that all three men were dressed in dark colored clothing like camouflage and had on dark oil type or paint or dark makeup on their faces to make them look like black people.

On 9/23/83 at 1P, CYNTHIA DAVIS came to my office where I did take a written statement of facts from her. She told me that on 9/22/83, at approximately 2A she was awakened by her roommate NANCY VANBEBBER screaming. She said that when she looked up she appeared to be three B/M entering her bedroom window. Said that she and NANCY VANBEBBER then ran to the other bedroom where her other roommates were, where they began trying to hold the door shut while the three B/M were trying to get into the apartment. She said that after all this screaming was going on and everything that someone was hollering out AVERY's name and when ELIZABETH AVERY looked out she recognized the SUSPECTS and then the SUSPECTS ran off to the other room to try to go out the window and when they ran back by she recognized one of the SUSPECTS as MONTY JAMES. She told me that she could positively say he was one of the SUSPECTS but she did not get a look at the rest of them. As CYNTHIA DAVIS also expressed her desire to file charges. On 9/23/83 at 2P, I was contacted in our office by LYNNE KLINKE and her father who was with her. At this time I did take a written statement of facts from her and she told me that she did not get a look at any of the SUSPECTS in the case. She said but they were all dressed in dark colored clothing like camouflage and had on dark colored make-up on their faces.

On 9/23/83, at 3P, I was contacted in my office by the above three SUSPECTS. They wanted to talk to me at 3:05P, 9/23/83. I did warn all of them of their rights off my OFFICERS' warning card. The spokesman for the three was MONTY JAMES. He told me he felt that they had done

into several different apartments and that everyone thought it was funny except these four girls. He said that they did go into the apartment and all three of them at this time admitted to me that they had gone into the apartment trying to scare the girls and said they did scare them and they all left laughing thinking it was very funny. Told me that they did not think anything would be done about this and that Baylor Officials would not do anything about this and wanted to know if I was going to file charges on them. Told me that that it was only a Baylor Prank. I told them that it looked like we would be filing charges against the three SUSPECTS. MONTY JAMES told me that he was sure that if we did file charges on him that when they took this to court that everybody would realize this and everybody would let them go. That he was sure that no one would pursue any charges against them in court. I assured MR. JAMES at this time that the Police did take this as a serious matter and not a college prank and that we would be investigating the case.

Officers were called to 1717 S. 2nd #7, on possibly a burglary that had just occurred, with the complainant and several of the people there, knowing who one of the subjects were. Upon arrival, we contacted MS. NANCY VANBEBBER, who stated that she is the one who called the police and that all four of the girls had rented the apartment together, but she was the one who called, so she said to use her name as the complainant in the case. She said that she had been awoken by one of the roommates, stating that someone was trying to come through the window. They remembered running into another bedroom, at which point MS. VANBEBBER said that she was so scared that she didn't remember anything of what had actually happened. It was necessary to talk to the other three witnesses, who were the young ladies at the scene, to find out what actually happened. We talked to MS. ELIZABETH AVERY, who stated that she was awoken when she heard somebody at the window. When she looked up, she noticed that there

appeared to be three, possibly black males, coming through the window. She got up, got MS. VANDEBBER up and they ran into another bedroom, closed the door and tried to hold the door shut. They had told one of the girls to call the police, but due to the fact that the phone was not in the other bedroom. While the other girls were trying to hold this door shut, the three subjects outside, one of them started calling the name of ELIZABETH AVERY, calling her last name. At which point, MS. AVERY did recognize the subject as RICHARD SHERMAN MILKS. The guys then ransacked the room and then left through the front door. MS. DAVIS stated that she was so mad when she found out that they were people that she knew, she started chasing them down the stairs and she was going to try to hit them, but the subjects left through the front door laughing, thinking it was a big joke. The other girls related basically the same information. They also said that they would assist in prosecution. When I talked to them, they stated that they did see anything missing at the time and they don't remember the subjects making any threats against them to do harm to them. OFFICER PESSINK was at the scene and will make a form 3 on this case. Also, OFFICER REEVES, with the Baylor PD, was there and took the same information that I did. He stated that they had had problems with this MR. MILKS before. He then went over with Baylor PD to 200 Cottonwood, #16, trying to contact this MR. MILKS, but was unable to contact him at this apartment. We had dispatcher attempt to call, but there was no answer on the phone at the residence.
